## Next Meeting:

## Minutes:

Nathan called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM. Loren gave the Treasurer's Report shortly after. Nathan read the minutes from the previous meeting.

**Old Business** – Nathan announced that after 4 years as President, he will not run for office next year.

Bill Phelps talked a little about a situation where a new person came to the field with a radio and almost turned it on while there was a 40% Carden Edge running. Loren suggested that members should

volunteer to help any new person at the field (member or guest) to acclimate that person with the rules and regulations of our flying site. It is in all of our best interests to keep the field as safe as possible. On that note, Skip suggested that we consider a flying rules sign at the field.

**New Business** – Skip Jacobs has been working with us and the Corps of Engineers to get us a shelter installed at the pit area of the field. It will be a simple structure that will be 12'x20' and it would be provided to us with the understanding that we would construct it. We also have the option to purchase a second shelter to be installed at the field in addition to the first. He mentioned that the club will need to provide an official letter of request for the shelter to be approved. Loren has agreed to write this letter on behalf of the club.

The club will be ordering fuel soon and we're looking for a place to store the fuel until it's been sold. We plan on ordering 64 gallons and selling it for \$13 which is at-cost to the club. Contact Loren if you are able to keep some fuel with you.
